

Roll of Communicants in the Second Presbyterian Church of Carlisle:

NOTE.—After the lapse of fifty years it seems proper to gather up the annals of our church and put them in a permanent form. In preparing this history it has seemed desirable to give, as one item, the complete Register of Communicants from the organization of the church to the present time. The utmost care has been taken to render the following record as complete and accurate as possible, but *humanum est errare*. Only those who have attempted to gather and verify such historical data as are embraced in the following records can have any adequate conception of the labor involved and the difficulty of attaining the fond ideal of perfect accuracy. The courteous proposal of the Editor of this paper to assist by putting the Register in print has been accepted with the hope that those friends, who are most interested in the accuracy of local history, will kindly render us their assistance in correcting any mistakes into which we may have fallen, and also by furnishing us the dates, if possible, which will be found wanting in this statement. We fondly hope to see the whole in a more permanent and accurate form at an early day, and, therefore, invite the assistance of those who have access to family records and other repositories of dates as yet undiscovered by us. It is the intention to give such accurate information, if possible, respecting each individual as will identify the relations of all, but no church censures will be made public.

Perhaps no apology is necessary for endeavoring to preserve these memorials of the fathers. Very few will call in question the sentiment attributed to Lord Macaulay: "The people who take no pride in the noble achievements of their ancestors will never achieve anything worthy to be remembered. All pride by remote descendants." The great American statesman, Daniel Webster says: "There is a moral and philosophical respect for our ancestors which elevates the character and improves the heart;" and the sententious Carlyle has left on record the opinion, "There is a great deal more in genealogies than is generally believed at present. I never heard of any clever man that came out of entirely stupid people," while a greater than any of these has said "The memory of the just is blessed." G. N. S.
